Week 11: November 12-16, 2023. Message from the Grade 5 Team:

ELA: This week in English Language Arts we are starting a new unit, Unit 3. The big question we are exploring in this unit is "How are animals and plants dependent on one another?". To answer it, we are reading, writing, and talking about how living things are connected.

- *Math:* In our math class we will continue exploring our Chapter 3, focusing on learning various strategies for dividing whole numbers.
- **Science:** We will continue with Unit 3 Cells to Body Systems. We'll explore how cells form tissues and organs specialized for body functions in multicellular organisms. The emphasis is on understanding how these subsystems interact and contribute to larger complex systems within the body.
