### Message from the Grade 5 Team:

- **ELA:** *“What is the power of the sun?” That is the big question we are exploring in this unit. To answer it, we are reading, writing, and talking about solar energy. Be a part of our exploration!*
- **Math:** *This week in our math lessons, we are diving into Chapter 3. Our focus will be on exploring various strategies used for dividing whole numbers.*
- **Science:** *We will continue with Unit 3 Cells to Body Systems. In multicellular organisms, the body is a system of multiple interacting subsystems. These subsystems are groups of cells that work together to form tissues and organs that are specialized for body functions. Systems may interact with other systems; they may have sub-systems and be a part of larger complex systems. Emphasis is on the conceptual understanding that cells form tissues and tissues form organs specialized for body functions.*
