**Week 27 (March 2<sup>nd</sup>.2025- March 6<sup>th</sup>.2025) science**

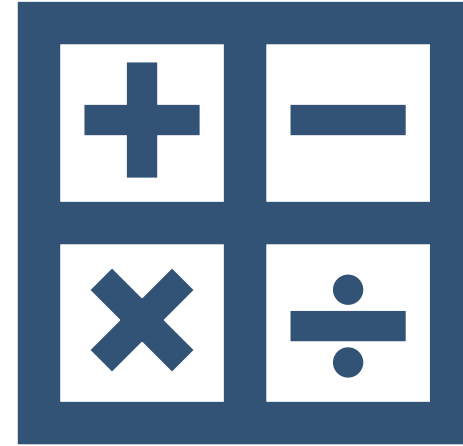
**Students will study the following:**

Greetings!

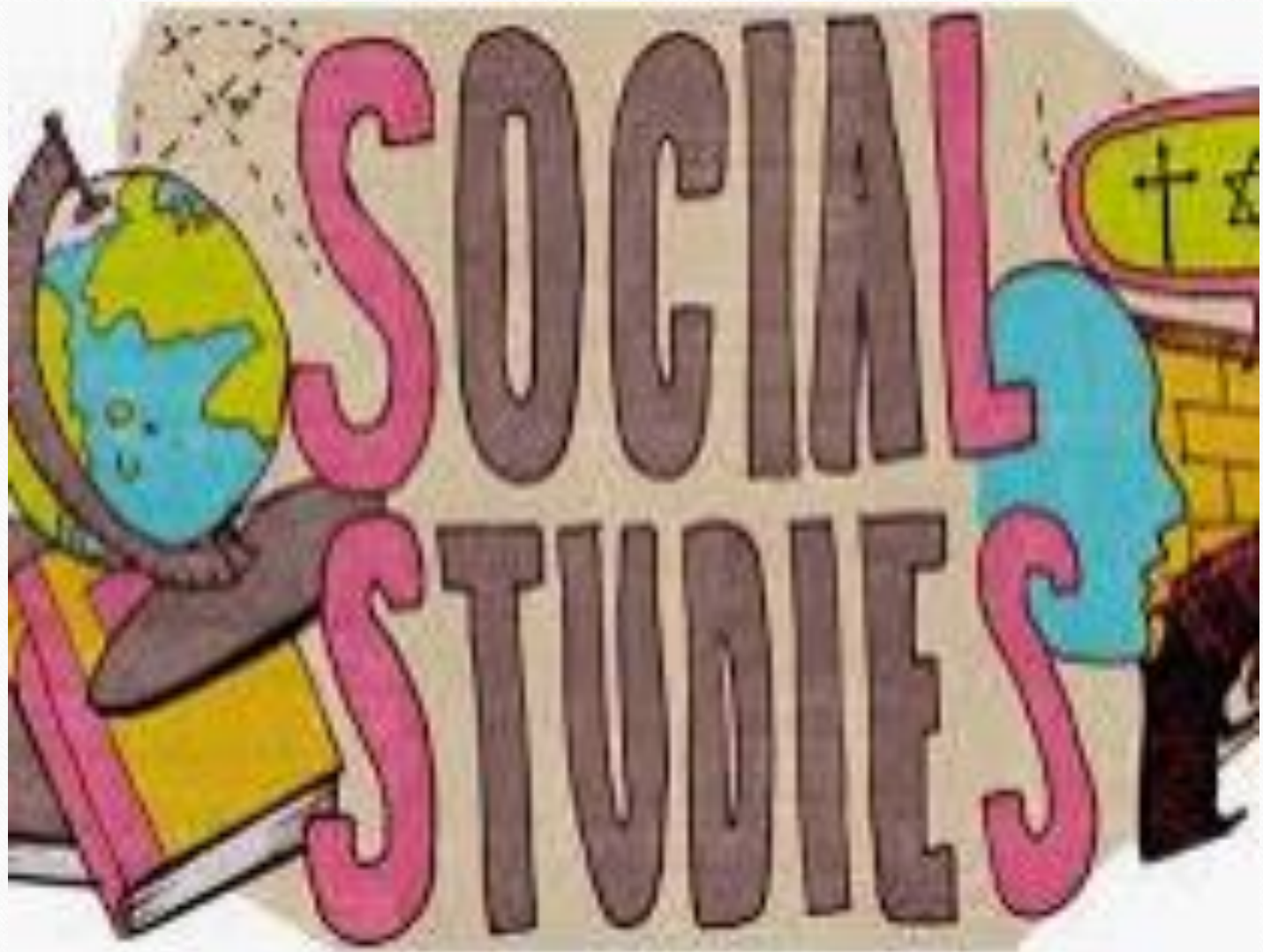
