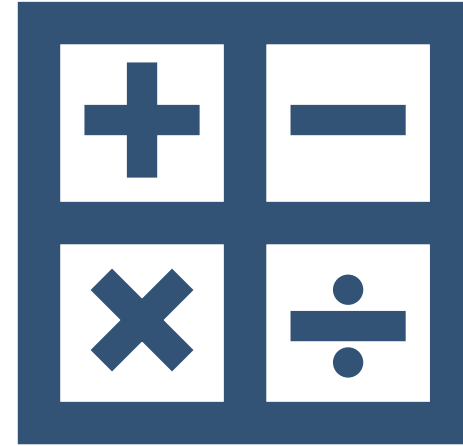
**Week 36 (May 4<sup>th</sup>.2025- May 8<sup>th</sup>.2025) science**

**Mathematics – Week-36: 04-May to 08-May.**

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*Grade-6 Math*  
*Week-36: 04-May – to – 08-May*

Students will learn solving one step addition and subtraction equations; they will also learn to check their solutions. Additionally, they will learn how to calculate the mean, and how to find the mode of a given set of data.

**Assessments This Week:**

- **TEST** on Wednesday, 07th of May. This TEST will contain questions of the following concepts:

Finding the location of a point on the coordinate plane, Identifying the coordinates of  
Solving one-step equations with inverse operations of addition and subtraction.

Vocabulary: variable, equation, solve, solution, LHS, RHS, inverse operations, undo, balance of an equation, and balanced equation, addition property of equality, subtraction property of equality.

Oral assessments will happen in class as part of teaching and learning (formative assessments).

Greetings!

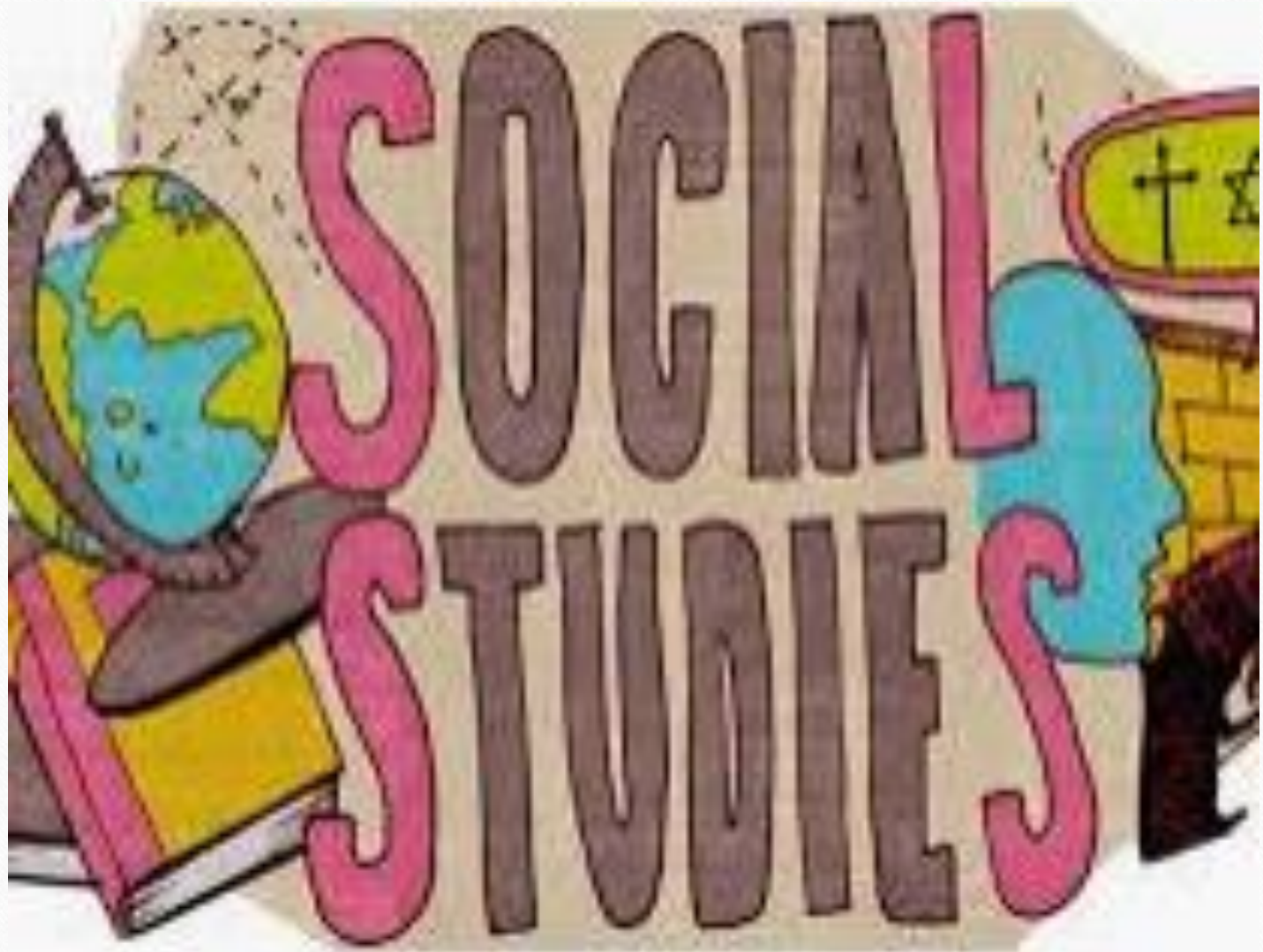
